

WHY DO WE NEED POSTDOCS?

Postdoctoral fellows were first authors on 43% of papers published in Science

Yet, Postdoctoral fellows comprise just over a third of research personnel.

More recent estimates = 50% of all research is conducted by Postdoctoral Fellows


