


Gender mainstreaming in 41 Swedish government agencies

2013-2014: First phase, 18 agencies 2015-2018: Second phase, 41 agencies

Purpose: To strengthen the gender equality work in government agencies **Aim:** For the agencies to improve their work with gender mainstreaming

- Plan for action


Support structure

- Documenting results


