

Nagasaki prefecture has complicated coast line with many peninsulas and bays, and it consists of many islands.

PURPOSE of PROGRM

- To introduce several pathways into the science filed, enhance motivation of junior and senior high schoolgirls to follow a science career
- To encourage parents and teachers to strengthen their ambition in extolling the benefits of a science course

GOAL of PROGRM

To build the foundation necessary to form a science career, and to foster and encourage women who actively contribute to society

targets number

- Total number of participants:
 junior and senior high schoolgirls 600
 parents / teachers 200
- attain satisfaction in the program is 90%
- increase science career consciousness by 50%
- increase consciousness of care and support by 50%
- the number of those involved in mass media by 5 times



- (2) Laboratory visit (Rikejo lecture and experiential practice)

Characteristic of **ADMIRATION SEMINAR**

knowing deeply about the world of science

- Visiting to the science job site to improve their admiration for a science career
- Introduction concerning women's work-life balance, and striving to eliminate worries related science-based jobs
- Exchange of ideas with undergraduate / graduate
 students as familiar role models to increase motivation
 to progress a science career

activities influence success of the program

- ① We gained cooperation from the Steering Committee, Venue High School and Board of Education to recruit participants
- ② A large number of undergraduate / graduate / international students participated in the program. They are familiar role models for junior and senior high schoolgirls, and improved young students' motivation to science career course
- ③ We aimed to disseminate information concerning the girls' selection of career paths widely in the community, and thus the Ambition seminar was held as an "open seminar" to the public where general citizens were invited to participate

CONCLUSION

- We have introduced our science course selection support program for junior and senior high schoolgirls, named "Rikejo development program to foster dreams, admiration, and ambition"
- Utilizing the resources of this region, we developed Nagasaki University model
