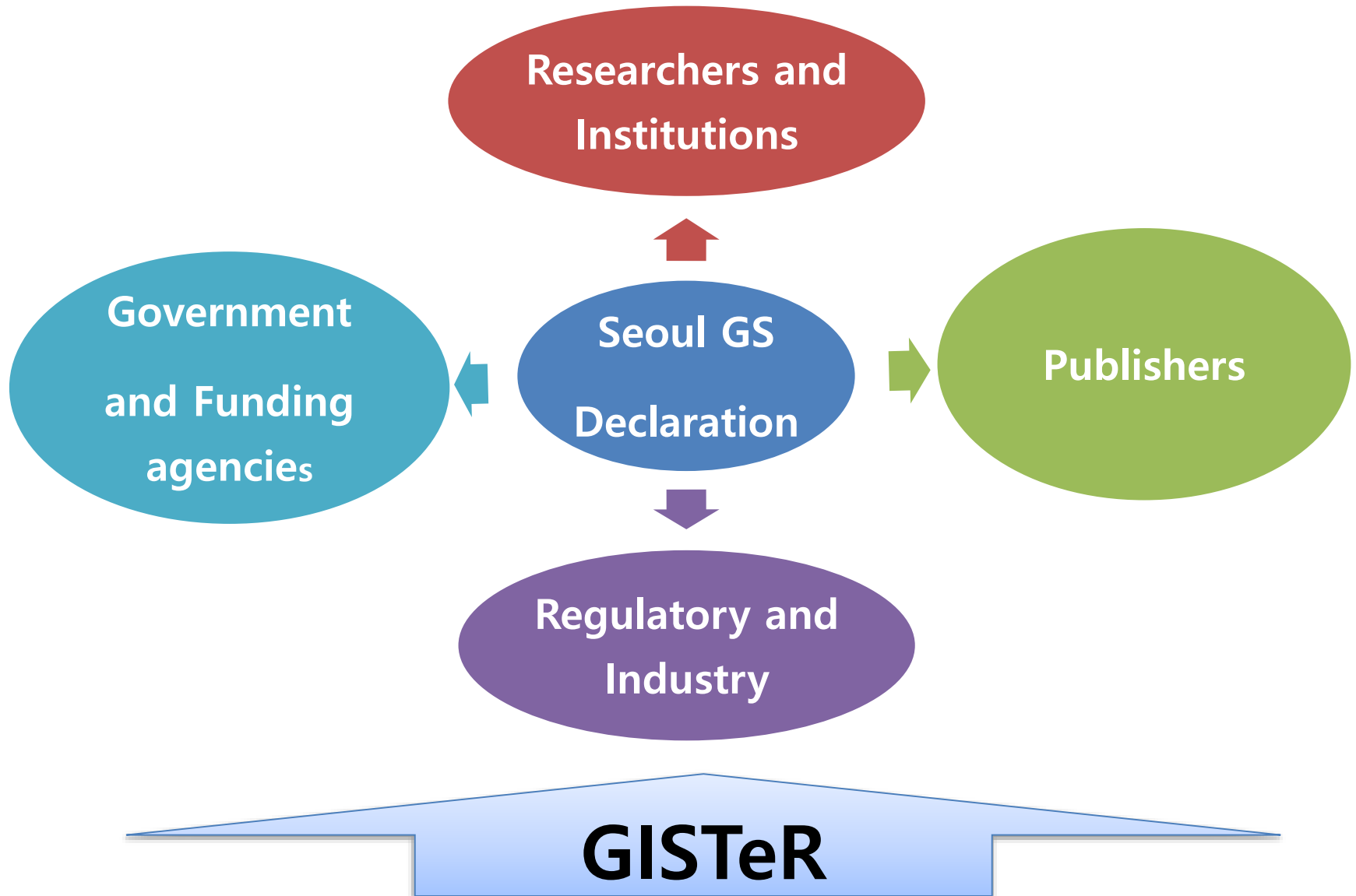

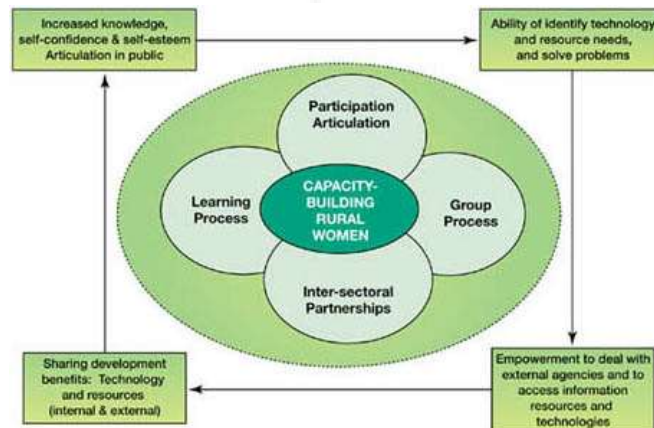


Female solar engineers can contribute to Climate change and home economy

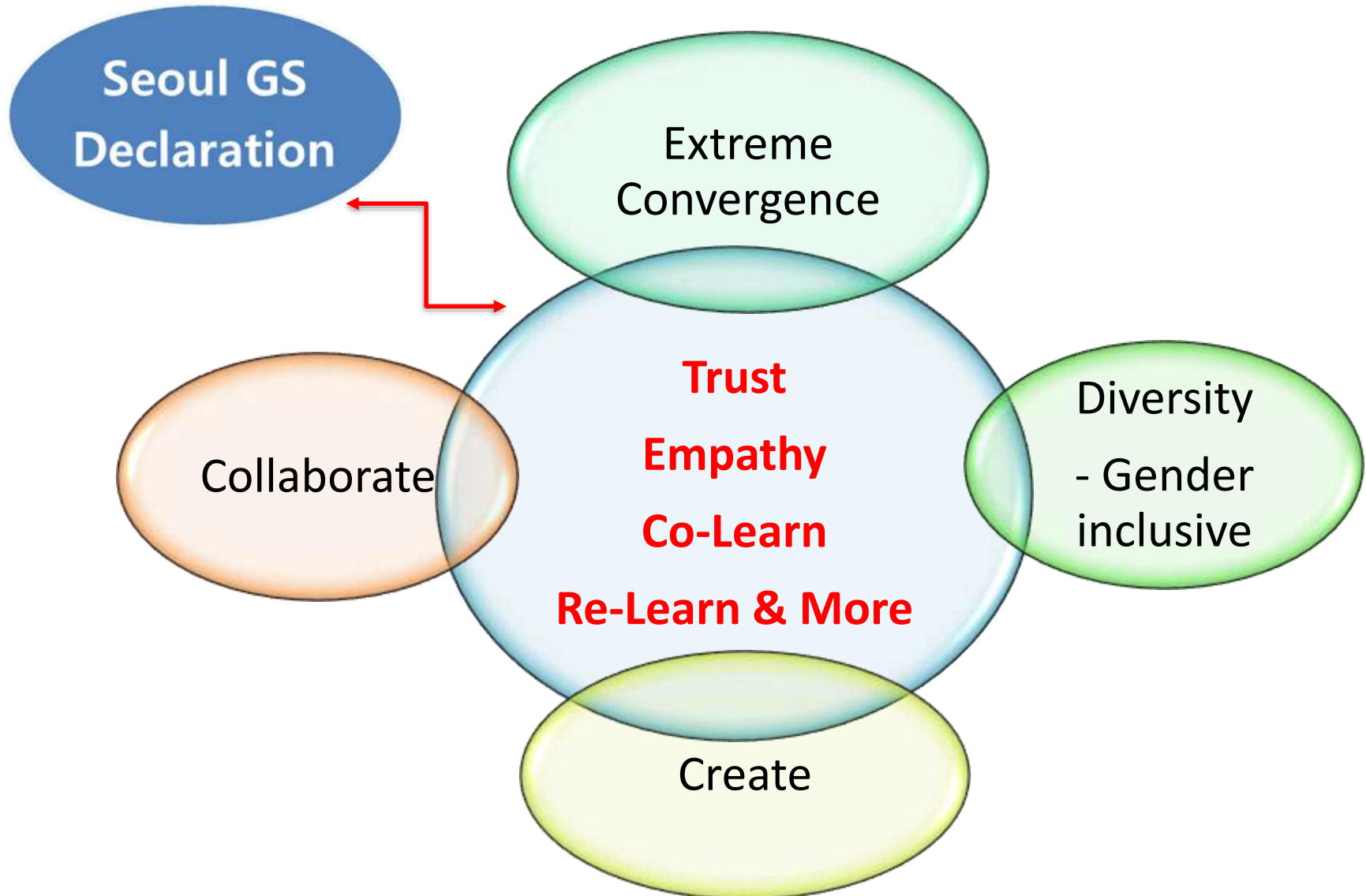
• **Science** (26.3.2010; Vol 327:1571-2):
